...INSULATING GARAGE WALLS. This is a very easy part of the project, you can probably complete it in one day. It can go even faster if you have two people working. One person measuring and cutting the insulation and the other setting it in place. Pull the hose back as the cavity fills. Ask your helper to stop the machine when you feel resistance and can no longer insert insulation. 4 Repeat steps 2 and 3, filling up the remaining wall cavities. 5 Once you have finished, reinsert the drywall cutouts and patch up and paint over the holes.
